



Quail Hollow Connector Trail

Trail Description

The 2.0 mile trail will serve as a multi-use pathway to connect the Lake Township Community Park near Lake Blue Streaks Stadium to the Hartville Memorial Park adjacent to Lake Elementary School. It will include a combination of paved and stoned sections.

Project Funding

The total estimated project cost is \$725,000. Stark Parks was awarded \$473,000 in Clean Ohio Trail grant funds from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to cover 75% of the project. Additional funds received from the Ohio Trail Partnership and Stream & Wetland Foundation Easement Fee.

Community Support

Hunter Yost, a student at Lake Middle/High School, advocated for the project through a local writing contest in 2023 emphasizing the importance of improving accessibility and fostering community connections in Hartville.

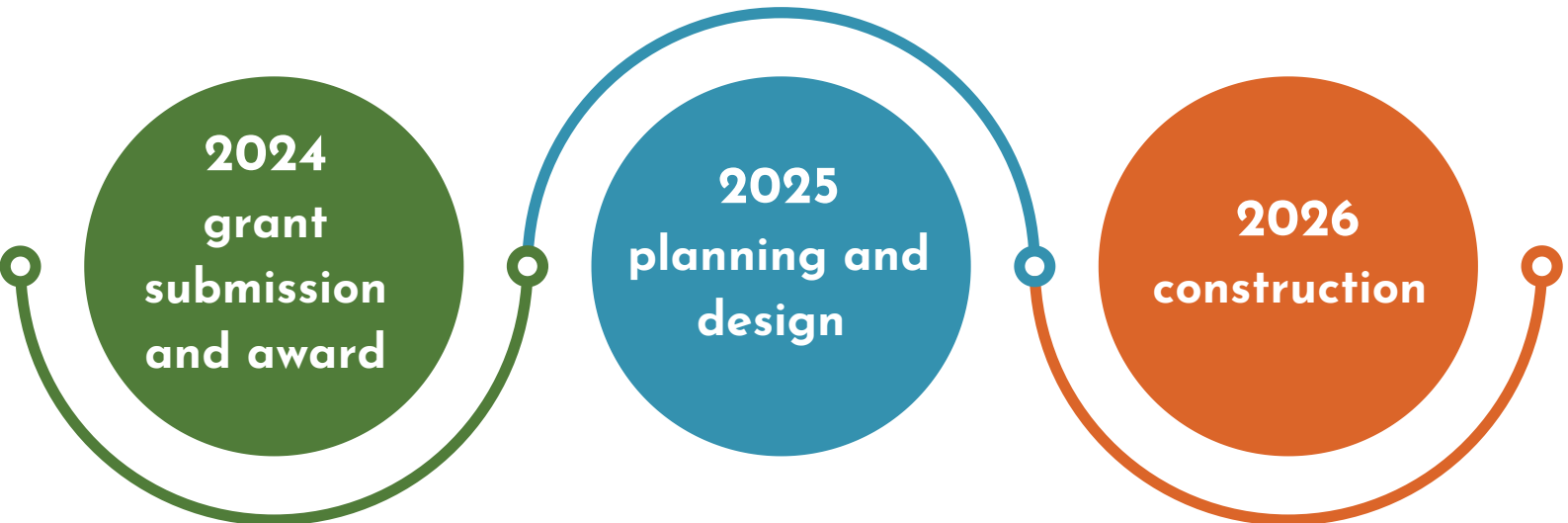
